APPEARANCE NOSE PALATE	Deep dark, limpid red colour. Swirling this wine in the glass brings forth a very complex bouquet. All the usual aromas of tobacco, black currant, cloves and a woodiness typical of ripe Cabernet are present, the hallmarks of a great wine. In the mouth, the first impression is both powerful and elegant, with rich flavors covering the palate. The tannins are very supple, lingering elegantly on the finish.
AGEING	Ageing for 12 months in medium toasted French-oak barrels, of which 40% new.
PAIRING	A perfect match with Asian dishes, hearty fish courses like tuna, mushrooms and pasta as well as cheese.
