REGION	Pauillac, Bordeaux, France
TECHNICAL DATA	Alcohol 13.5%
APPEARANCE	The wine is a deep, crimson-hued red.
NOSE	The full and expressive nose opens on black fruit aromas with refined touches of roasted coffee-bean. With time, the bouquet becomes more intense, revealing morello cherry aromas and succulent notes of confectionery.
PALATE	The rich, structured attack shows perfectly ripe fruit, while the packed and generous mid-palate combines blackcurrant and liquorice flavours, set off by abundant and remarkably well-constructed tannins.
AGEING	Matured in a combination of 30% new oak barrels and 2nd fill barrels from Mouton Rothschild.
PAIRING	Grilled or roasted red meats and hard cheese are the ideal match.
