APPEARANCE	Deep red colour with crimson highlights.
NOSE	Powerful, intense and complex bouquet, bursting with notes of ripe, black fruit, particularly blackcurrant. Spicy and subtle overtones are already perceptible.
PALATE	The attack is broad-based and fleshy, with a remarkably caressing sensation, becoming full-bodied, with smooth and fine-grained tannins mid-palate. The finish is long, without any hardness whatsoever.
AGEING	18 months in 40% new oak barrels.
PAIRING	This powerful red goes perfectly with red onion stuffed with couscous and apricots, boeuf bourguignon or vegetable couscous with beef meatballs.
