PALATE	Medium to full-bodied, deep and quite extracted in style, this is a rich, fleshy wine complemented by a lively acid structure.
AGEING	Aging mainly in French oak barriques, with about 10% aging in large oak foudres. The wine spend 18 months in barrels.
PAIRING	Best served with all types of classic meat dishes, veal, pork, beef, lamb, duck, game, roasted, braised, and grilled dishes.
