PALATE	The wine is clean in the attack with the rounded, fruity Merlot offering a gourmet touch. Thanks to the Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot, the mid-palate is dense, leading to a persistent and highly appealing finish.
AGEING	12 months in French oak barrels.
PAIRING	This Pessac-Leognan red will go well with quail with figs, grilled lamb chops or beef tenderloin in foie gras crust.
