NOSE	Ripe damson-plum, candied orange, and spice aromas of tobacco, mint, dried forest leaves and licorice pour from the glass of this ripe and generous St-Emilion.
PALATE	The attack is clear, the wine progressively gets bigger, reaching a very sophisticated balance between the magnificent quality of tannins, substance, tension and freshness.
AGEING	Aged for 20 to 22 months in 100% new French oak barrels.
PAIRING	Thanks to the 50/50 blend, the 2014 vintage leans into its Cabernet Franc profile and makes it a dream pairing for meats with a distinctive earth, herbal, or gamey edge.
