TECHNICAL DATA	Alcohol 13.5%
APPEARANCE	The colour is a deep garnet red with a purple tint.
NOSE	The refined and elegant nose displays ripe fruit, while hints of graphite and liquorice together with aromatic verbena notes leave an impression of sappy freshness.
PALATE	From a very full-bodied attack, the flavours build towards a rich and harmonious balance. The tannins are well-rounded, silky and creamy, underpinning the expression of spicy, judicious oak. The long and full finish is sustained by an attractive freshness on vanilla and forest floor notes.
AGEING	Matured in 30% new oak for 18 months.
PAIRING	Mainly grilled meats, roasted lamb, earthy mushrooms and aged hard cheeses.
