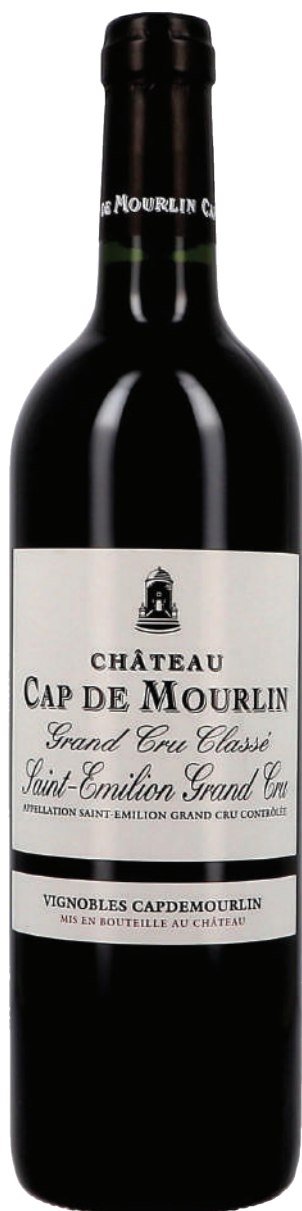




CHÂTEAU CAP DE MOURLIN

VARIETALS	65% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

REGION	Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France
TECHNICAL DATA	Alcohol 14%
APPEARANCE	Deep ruby red.
NOSE	Generous and intense, opening with rich aromas of sour cherry, blackberry, plum jam, and sweet elderberries, layered with complex undertones of cocoa, espresso bean, smoky tobacco leaf, and subtle licorice.
PALATE	Medium-to-full-bodied and velvety. It is structured with soft, mature tannins and a balancing acidity that prevents it from feeling heavy, finishing on a lingering note of mocha and fine spices.
AGEING	The wine is aged for 15 to 18 months in oak barrels, 50% new and 50% in 1 year old.
PAIRING	Pairs exceptionally well with braised beef, roasted lamb, venison, duck, mushrooms, and rich pasta dishes.
