APPEARANCE	The colour is deep, a dense opaque purple. The intense bouquet is open and fine, with menthol and spiced notes complemented by nicely mature black fruit notes. The attack on the palate is very fleshy and swiftly marked by a remarkable density. The freshness resulting from the natural concentration is underlined by an intense and fine tannic structure, with a slightly softened sensation, but a sober palate that remains somewhat austere. The finish is long and fruity with hints of liquorice.
